## **Principles and Criteria**

We need to establish Principles to be applied to any development and site selection.

Please answer the following questions:-

- 1. Should development cause the village outline to draw nearer to Bishop's Cleeve?
- 2. Should Gotherington remain a linear village, or be centrally developed?
- 3. Should development be phased over 16 years until 2031 or built as soon as possible?
- 4. Should development be in one broad area, or spread over several sites?
- 5. Should the housing development be made to follow the Gotherington Village Design Statement (VDS)? - See board 4
- 6. Should we ensure that our green areas, Important Open Spaces and views are preserved as stated in our VDS?
- 7. Should our Neighbourhood Development Plan clearly state that the impact of development on village road traffic should be minimised?

We also need to establish the *importance* of various criteria applied to suggested development sites.

Please answer the following questions:-

- 1. Should development only be allowed outside the Village, on the edge of the Village or within the Village?
- 2. Should development only be allowed where there is no likelihood of flooding from heavy rainfall, or is it acceptable where there is a medium likelihood of flooding from heavy rainfall?
- 3. Should development only be allowed in areas which are not designated AONB or SLA? (Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty or Special Landscape Area)
- 4. How important is it for any future development to be near to the shop, the village hall, the school or the Shutter Inn?
- 5. How important is it for any future development to be near to a bus stop or bus route?
- 6. Should development be allowed if it has an impact on local views?
- 7. How important is it if future development affects existing neighbours?
- 8. Should development be allowed if it has an impact on listed buildings or other heritage assets?
